Polymer Drive Site: Located one mile off North/South Interstate 75, just off Highway 153. The site is within one mile of the Chattanooga Airport.

Amnicola Highway Site: The site is located on the banks of the Tennessee River, within four miles of downtown Chattanooga.

Product/Uses:

Styrene-Butadiene Polymer Dispersions: Uses include adhesives, carpet backing, foams, paper coatings, and asphalt modifiers.

Site Overview:

Both Chattanooga facilities have a long history of excellent safety and environmental performance. The site has reduced emissions of air pollutants by 98 percent since 1988. The Amnicola production facility sits adjacent to the Tennessee River and beside the Tennessee River Park. The River Park walkway traverses the length of the site in a demonstration of the successful coexistence of the chemical industry and community recreational assets. The site is also home to the Chattanooga based "TRACER" team. This team is trained and equipped to respond to incidents associated with the transportation and use of chemical products. The team regularly participates in joint emergency practice sessions with the Chattanooga Fire Department.
