Product/Uses:

- **Clearcoat:** This is the final coating layer on an automobile. It provides a clear, lustrous and durable finish.
- **Electrocoat:** This is the first coating layer on an automobile. It provides corrosion protection and prepares the surface for additional coating layers.
- **Resins:** A variety of resins including acrylics, polyurethanes, polyesters and epoxies are manufactured at the Greenville site. The resins are used to produce a variety of coatings for automotive (both OEM and refinish), industrial and coil coatings applications.
