- ARSENAL® Herbicide: Controls vegetation along railroad and utility rights-of-way, highways, fence lines; also controls hard woods in pine forested areas
- ALVERDE® Insecticide: Protects crops from some of the most economically important pests, including the Colorado potato beetle, diamondback moth and the beet army worm
- CADRE® Herbicide: Controls more than 34 grasses and broadleaf weeds in peanuts
- PHANTOM® Termiticide-Insecticide: Provides general pest solution for both homeowners and commercial customers
- '268, MMPDC Intermediate: Controls all insects and mites, even those resistant to other compounds
- EXTREME® Herbicide: Enhances control of grass and key broadleaf weeds, such as black nightshade, velvetleaf and lambsquarters
